Patrick Howard:

Patrick gave an overview of what The Web Company do and their history to date.

- He started the company in 2004 with 2 staff members
- The company currently employs 16 staff – 2 of whom joined recently
- Patrick works in a sales role and leaves the coding of pages to his staff members
- Their target is small to medium sized businesses and they are currently rebuilding the Waitakere Enterprise website
- As well as making money they try to put back money into the community. They are supporters of Sunderland School and also our very own Soapbox Derby
- Every year they offer two free websites to deserving causes and are taking applications now for an August decision
- As well as this they have offered to upgrade our website – and host it on their servers for free.

History of our Website to date:

- During Monique Mataga's reign as president she arranged for her daughter to build the Waitakere City Rotary website: <http://www.rotarywaitakere.org.nz/>
- This grew to become quite a complex site and, once Buzzy moved on to other projects, there wasn't anyone with the skills in the Club to update it so it remained untouched for three or four years
- Heather attempted to update the site last year but, for a whole lot of technical reasons, found it easier to re-create it using a different menu and behind the scenes structure. - Patrick's offer of finishing it is more than welcome as time is still in short supply.
- Tonight Patrick unveiled a new "look and feel" for the website. The structure and content to date will remain much the same as Heather's draft version – but The Web Company's proposed version looks far more professional. <http://www.webcoclients.co.nz/rotary/>

- Our existing site has been moved to The Web Companies servers and pages will be updated shortly.
