



Report on tree planting Wednesday 5th Aug.

Te Atatu Intermediate went up to Wairere Road Waitakere the property planted at last year. Thirty five students, 2 Teachers and 3 Parents spent a great day planting 350 plants adjacent to last years planting. Last years plants are now on average over half a meter high with a very good strike rate. The children who planted last year where rapt to see the result of last years efforts and the first timers are now looking forward to visiting and planting more next year. All in all a very rewarding day especially to see the enthusiasm among the students. Rest assured that the Tree for Survival program that Rotary supports is worthwhile.
