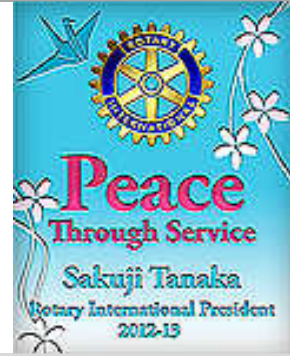


Phil and Barry
