A memory he shared from his past was Kerry sitting outside his house on the back of a truck playing a pianola. It was powered by Hew's Mum's vacuum cleaner.

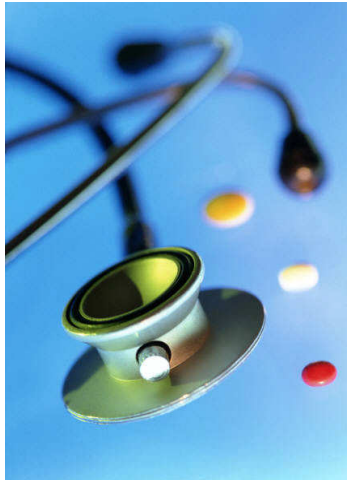
