He has promised to attend more Rotary meetings over the remainder of this term than he has been able to in recent months to make up for his forthcoming desertion.

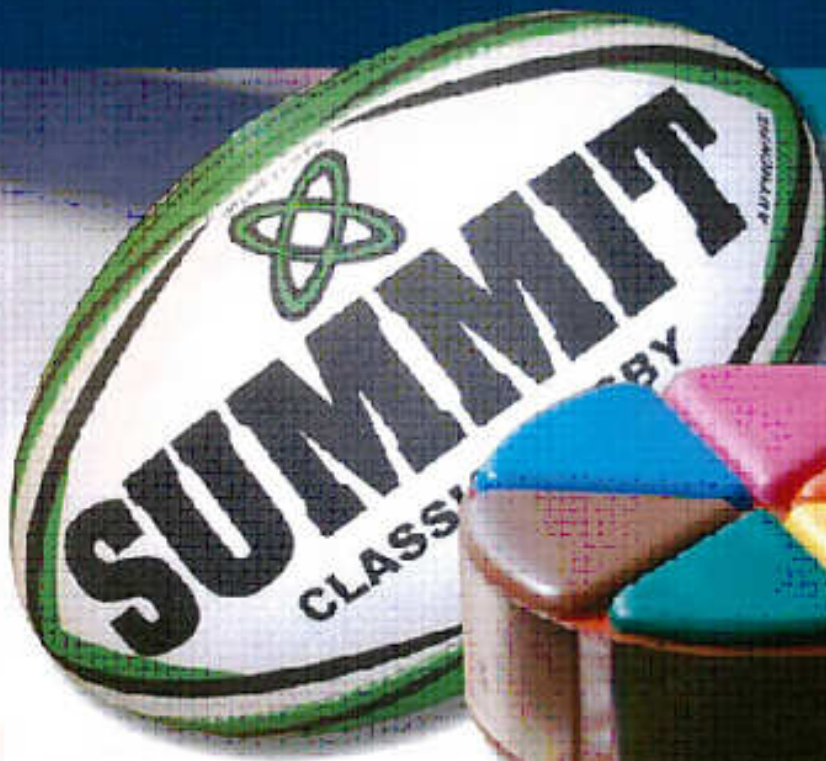
## WEBSITE STATISTICS
