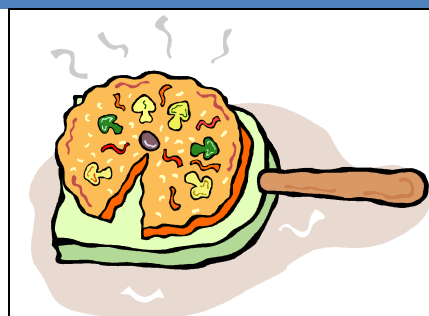
THIS WEEK: CLUB NIGHT
