To all the Scotsmen and women in the club, in Rotary and well, in the world – some photos that will back memories of our cultural evening, celebrating a Scottish tradition.

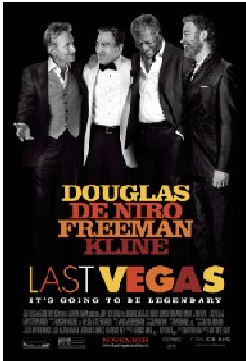


Welcome to our New Member - Monique
