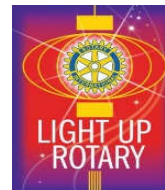
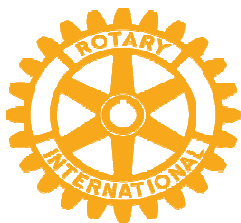

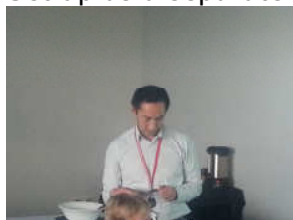


Waitakere News

Andrew Young spoke to us from the Well Foundation Waitemata. The Well Foundation is the official fundraising body of the Waitemata DHB, which includes Waitakere and North Shore hospitals and community health services in West Auckland, North Shore and Rodney.

Set up as a separate charitable trust, the foundation's mission is to help the Waitemata DHB deliver its promise of "best care for everyone" by raising additional funds for priority projects that support innovation, smart use of technology and new initiatives that will enable the DHB to be a leader in healthcare.



Donations and support raised through the foundation will be carefully managed and used on agreed projects and kept distinct from the annual Government funding the DHB is allocated for its basic, core services.
