For years Tommy and Marilyn Waters have been helping Kiwi racers at the world trolley derby finals in Akron, Ohio.


The Morganton, North Carolina couple has welcomed New Zealand visitors, shown them the sights, and provided tips and support to aid the Kiwis in their international races.

In appreciation of their efforts, New Zealand trolley derby race director Terry Clarkson of Orewa invited them here before the Whangaparaoa Rotary Trolley Derby regional event on Saturday and Sunday's national final, both at Brightside Rd in Stanmore Bay from 9am to 4pm.

Tommy and Marilyn were guests at the Rotary Club of Whangaparaoa's meeting in the Silverdale RSA last week and are staying here for several days.

"They've done a great job of looking after Kiwis, particularly the young racers whose trip to the US has often been their first," Terry says.

At the same meeting St John Hibiscus Coast cadets divisional manager Andrew Graham of Red Beach demonstrated the new resuscitation models the derby will be helping buy. The Resusci Anne models worth about \$2200 each come with a \$1400 electronic pad which shows how well trainees are performing CPR.

They come with an electronic pad worth \$1400 that tells how good the resuscitator's technique is and where improvements can be made, with the information able to be taken from six dummies at the same time.
