# A Joint Waitakere / Auckland East Derby

Last year we joined Northcote for a Rain Date Derby, this year Auckland East has approached us for help. They have fewer cars than normal along with a sponsorship issue so asked us if they could join us at our race.

We shall do much the same as we did at Northcote last year. Run the two sets of races as separate races but slot them together. This leads to faster turnaround between races as everyone gets extra pit time before their car races again.

Our teams' pits will be on the verge on Westgate Drive, Auckland East teams will be based in Cabernet Crescent.

## **Rain Date**

As Auckland East were OUR rain date we have arranged a new rain date at our venue with Council

The new Rain Date is Sunday 23rd March at Westgate Drive.

#### **Forms**

How would the world exist if it wasn't for forms?

Drivers forms, team members forms, corporate car driver form AND superkid forms are on the website.

As it takes time to get them filled in and back (they go missing in school bags and/or end up on the fridge) please download them now and we might just get them back in time for the drivers to race.

The latest AASBD rules state:

A-3.02 Participants in the Super Stock Division must be nine (9) years of age by July 31 in the race year that they participate. They must not turn nineteen (19) years of age on or before July 31.

Proof of age is required.

Please check your drivers' ages and note that all Finalists are required to provide a copy of a birth certificate or passport BEFORE racing in the NZ Finals.

The reason for this is: Whilst we trust our schools to check their driver's ages a copy of the winner's proof of age must be emailed to America within 24 hours of the race.

Immediately after the NZ Finals is NOT the time to discover:

- a. There was a data entry error in the school database or
- b. The parents say, "We lost the ID in the last move... Where do we get a new copy from?"


