What is a Safety Day?

- This is the day we check all the cars to ensure they are built correctly, safe to race and pass our "WOF"
- Our Race Director also gives a Safety Briefing to the children
- Attendance is **compulsory**... but inevitably there will be one or two who can't make it for legitimate reasons other sports practice or school camp spring to mind if this applies to you let us know

Forms

How would the world exist if it wasn't for forms?

Drivers forms, team members forms, corporate car driver form AND superkid forms are on the website.

As it takes time to get them filled in and back (they go missing in school bags and/or end up on the fridge) please download them now and we might just get them back in time for the drivers to race.

If you can bring them to the Safety Brief it is less work for you than scanning and emailing them later.

The latest AASBD rules state:

A-3.02 Participants in the Super Stock Division must be nine (9) years of age by July 31 in the race year that they participate. They must not turn nineteen (19) years of age on or before July 31.

Please check your drivers' ages and note that all Finalists are required to provide a copy of a birth certificate or passport **BEFORE racing in the NZ Finals**.

The reason for this is: Whilst we trust our schools to check their driver's ages for the local race a copy of the winner's proof of age must be emailed to America within 24 hours of the race.

Immediately after the NZ Finals is NOT the time to discover:

- a. There was a data entry error in the school database or
- b. The parents say, "We lost the ID in the last move or, the dog ate it... Where do we get a new copy from?"

- start your drivers on flatter, shorter tracks and build up slowly!


